Russia and NATO: the most dangerous game in the world

Whoever committed that massacre (it seems that it is most likely that it was the Russian soldiers) will remain in the annals of history as an unforgivable crime. But I think the smoke doesn't let you see the horizon. You don't see where we came from and, worse, you don't see where we're going. Although I have repeated it in different media since long before the war, wrong or not, I will insist on those two sides of the road that the fire does not let you see.

Let us begin with a simple and more immediate question: instead of continuing the endless, dangerous and well-known useless game of arbitral sanctions, why are there no obligation to negotiate a resolution to the conflict between Russia and NATO once and for all and before innocents continue to die?

A reasonable solution would be the dissolution of NATO in exchange for Russia's withdrawal from Ukraine, but that would be branded as radical. Business owners don't negotiate.

There are many other options, such as the most obvious and pragmatic, that is, the neutrality status of Ukraine (with provincial autonomy of the Dombas), which is where it should have started instead of provoking Russia to integrate Ukraine into NATO and deploy missiles four minutes from Moscow.

Nato's neutrality or non-membership has always been the case in Austria, Finland, Sweden and other neighbouring countries, some of which have just expressed the possibility of joining NATO, demonstrating where the business of the old war merchants is going and demonstrating, once again, that not only in Latin America the fight against communism was nothing more than the perfect excuse to maintain geopolitical dominance and protecting corporate, class and capital interests.

What do they intend, apart from expanding militarization more and more in a world, now that they have run out of the excuse of communism and, more recently, of Islamic terrorism, the one that in Afghanistan alone left eight trillion dollars of profits to the big companies specialized in "security"?

Do you think that a Russia surrounded by this anachronistic and mafia-like NATO organization would make Europe and the world a safer place?

You have to be under the influence of alcohol to forget that we are talking about one of the two atomic superpowers and imagine such stupidity. Or such an evil of organized crime. If it were really about "security", if they were really sincere about the "right to defend themselves" that countries have, they would never have tried to break this order that, judging by the ongoing war, has not made the world safer, but quite the opposite. Much less ukraine.

Of course, those who have that power to negotiate are not being splashed with the blood of Russians and Ukrainians but, on the contrary, are doing their business, so maybe it will take a few weeks, if not months, to stop falling crocodile tears on whiskey and start negotiating in earnest.
