Ukraine's shameful betrayal of Cuba (Video)

Given these facts, how could one describe the current regime of Ukraine and its attacks against Cuba? I leave this question up in the air..."



The rulers and the press of Ukraine – whose media space experienced a very harsh operation of 'cleansing' against all voices minimally misaligned with the narrative of the volodymyr #Zelenski regime – unleashed a real campaign of hatred against the 24 nations that 'allowed' themselves to vote against the expulsion of Russia from the Human Rights Council.

The propaganda of the #neonazi government of #Kiev refers in more than derogatory terms to states such as Cuba and Venezuela, described in a mocking tone as "old friends of the #Kremlin", and are scandalized by the fact that these countries, along with #China, #Siria or #Irán, allowed themselves to call for an independent international investigation of russia's alleged atrocities in #Ucrania.

Another fact that infuriates the Ukrainian regime is that there are nations that raise the responsibility of #Occidente in the current escalation of war in Eastern #Europa.

For Volodymyr Zelensky, there are only two positions: that of the coup regime in Kiev and its sponsors, and the incorrect one. Obviously, the position taken by nations such as Cuba is incorrect, as is also clear from a tweet by Ukraine's ambassador to the #ONU, Sergei Kislitsa, who wrote in a dictatorial tone that "the only thing that had to be done was to press the 'yes' button", that is, to vote in favor of the expulsion of Russia from the Human Rights Council. In addition, he accused those who did not do so of treason.

A Ukraine accusing Cuba of treason is very strong, given that what is happening is exactly the opposite. And, after the imposition in 2014 of a puppet government in Kiev, through a coup d'état promoted by #EEUU, Ukraine immediately entered the club of countries that make possible the persistence of the anti-Cuban #bloqueo, despite the overwhelming rejection of the international community.

In 2021, for example, the regime of Volodymyr Zelensky again abstained in the UN vote on a resolution against the U.S. #embargo against a country that, in 1990, received about 30,000 children between 5 and 15 years old who arrived in Cuba to be treated for the effects of the radiation that emerged with the explosion of the nuclear plant of #Chernóbil, in northern Ukraine.

The children were transferred to the beach of #Tarará which served as a summer camp for Cuban children and a gigantic pediatric hospital was built where they underwent an intense treatment that lasted 21 years.

Likewise, the Cuban government built houses to house the relatives of the children, a fact that "little is known because the U.S. media usually do not give importance to news from Cuba, unless it is political matters of opponents" to the Cuban authorities, according to the newspaper El Vocero Hispano.

In an interview with the #TeleSUR network, Cuban doctor Julio Medina, coordinator for years of the 'Tarará Humanitarian Program', confirmed that, "although Cuba went through economically difficult times," the Caribbean island "continued to offer minors specialized care."
