Venezuela International Summit Against Fascism

The head of Venezuelan diplomacy highlighted the debate against the interventionist imposition that is taking place in this meeting. There was also a strong rejection of the expansionism of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) and imperialism.



Last Monday, April 11, on the 20th anniversary of the coup d'état against President Hugo Chávez, which removed the eternal commander from power for 48 hours, Venezuela began in Caracas the International Summit against Fascism, as part of the commemorative activities.



From that date until the 13th, several commemorative acts of the popular counter-coup of 2002 were held, in which the consequences of the imperialist policies of the United States in the world and its attempt at hegemony were reflected.

This event was installed in the Yellow House Antonio José de Sucre, by Foreign Minister Félix Plasencia who reaffirmed Venezuela's commitment in defense of multilateralist, multipolar freedom and sovereignty in favor of peace and full democracy. Regarding the anniversary, the foreign minister commented that 20 years ago it was intended to thwart a kind, loving political project, to give everyone what they had been denied for 200 years of republican life.

The "International Summit Against Fascism" has about 200 guests from five continents. It was a three-day meeting in which the coup d'état 20 years ago and the reaction of the
