What surprises us? Cristina condenses a whole history of political, symbolic, verbal, gender and media violence in her body. The focus of a story of hatred fed with many

hours of air, on TV, on radios, on networks. The escalation of violence -also- takes a lot

of street, years of marches calling for the death of Cristina.

"We have also seen them hang mortuary bags on the bars of the Government House with

the faces of the main leaders of our political space, but the violent ones are us. The degree

of cynicism and perversion is incredible. They want to exterminate Peronism. It's what

they've always wanted. They have tried everything, the worst violence. The disappearance

of thousands of compatriots," Cristina said just a few days ago, at the weekend, when we

saw the actions of the police against political leaders and the popular mobilization at the

corner of Juncal and Uruguay.

The repudiation from different sectors does not take long to arrive. The same journalists

and politicians who constantly and systematically encourage messages of hatred, of

death, of "it's them or us," now strive for respect for the republic and its institutions.

Repudiation is necessary, but it does not absolve those who daily engender violence with

their speeches and actions.

"Love defeats hate" has been a slogan that has been encouraged by the militancy that

accompanied Nestor and accompanies Cristina. How do you build a country out of hatred?

How freely have those who claim to defend freedom of expression expressed themselves?

How much violence can be naturalized? How much more will the right, the oligarchy and

the media corporations continue to pierce democracy? Who pays the cost of the attack on

the Vice President?

How do you rebuild a country from hatred? It is built, as Norita Cortiñas says,

feeding "the feeling of resistance with all the love possible".
