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Is fascism the future of humanity?

The October 29 marked the hundredth anniversary of the March on Rome, an assault that installed (legally) Benito Mussolini in power in Italy. On the same day, was the anniversary of the creation of the Falangist Party of Spain, founded by the dictator Primo

de Rivera in 1933 to initiate the destruction of the Second Republic, a rare democratic experience that universalized the vote and created thousands of public schools in their few years of existence.

The October 29 of this year a rock concert was held in Mexico City Nazi (also known as RAC, *Rock Against Communism*) titled "The Empire Strikes Back", which brought together 300 attendees convinced of his race superior. Precisely, the idea and obsession of a replacement and annihilation of "The Beautiful Race" had already been articulated in books published in the empires. Anglo-Saxons at the end of the nineteenth century, all matured in the long experience slaveholder and in the frustrations of defeat in the Civil War, long before that Hitler was inspired by these "freedom-loving patriots."

Little by little, this Catharsis led to the rescue and reinforcement of an ideology that had been propagated a century earlier with the novelty of radio. Later that the Soviet Union defeated Hitler (with the help of his ally, Washington), conservatives in the United States banned reds from entering the country. The American Communist Party was full of blacks and the FBI was going after homosexuals because of their status as future communists. In 1954 they banned that match. They didn't mind hiring a thousand German Nazis for NASA and letting in another nine thousand "refugees". Even today the immigration and immigration procedures Nationalization ask if the applicant has ever belonged to a communist party (Donald Trump's in-laws skipped that question) and A word about belonging to some fascist or neo-Nazi group.

In Mexico, the Nazis did not have the overwhelming success they had in the United States before the war. His membership was barely around 150 enthusiasts. The The relationship between the government of Lázaro Cárdenas and Hitler was purely strategic (the Replacing the United States as a customer for a few years made possible the

nationalization of Mexican oil). More intense and ideological was the Hitler's relationship with Washington and, above all, with the great men of business of that country.

But the fascists and neo-Nazis who today penetrate Latin America are better off. They are more dangerous, even more dangerous than the Nazis who escaped to South America or those sent by the CIA to "fight communism", supporting dictatorships that protected the interests of transnationals.

Now Between November 28 and 29, dozens of far-right politicians international will meet in Mexico City at an event organized by the Movement Viva Mexico and the Conservative Political Action Conference (CPAC) Conservative Action Policy) in a fascist international. After decades, CPAC has decided to leave the United States and hold events propaganda in Brazil and Mexico.

To This event will be attended, among others, the Chilean son of Nazi, Pinochet convinced and businessman José Antonio Kast; the Argentine Boris Johnson, Javier Milei; the son of Brazilian President Eduardo Bolsonaro; The strategist of Donald Trump and instigator of the storming of the Capitol, Steve Bannon; the grandson of the dictator Rafael Trujillo and American businessman, Ramfis Dominguez-Trujillo; the daughter of Guatemalan genocidal Efraín Ríos Montt and congressman for his country, Zuri Ríos; and a few dozen other distinguished speakers. All Caucasian and with a preference for blue eyes, with the sole exception of Indo-American Shiva Ayyadurai, who presents himself as "The inventor of the email", even though email had already developed in while he was a child in India. But hey, we know that reality for these people doesn't count. but what they believe and say it is.

The The first speaker will be the ultraconservative Catholic Lech Walesa, according to whom "the sexual minorities oppress heterosexuals." In many of them, since Trump until Milei, body language is more important than your ideas. His furious speeches are similar to those of Hitler and Mussolini. Then and now, they express The frustration of a class that already knows that it is not an empire or that does not rule about the peonada, but does not know who to blame but those below who can not be defend not even with a vote, as is the case with immigrants.

Although to the so-called *patriotism*, in Latin America right-wing ideologies They have been imported and imposed from above and from outside. The cultures of the native peoples were always more akin to what in the West was called "left." One of the guests at CPAC, the Mexican and congresswoman from Texas, Mayra Flores, assures that "*Mexicans are conservatives.*" Herself It refers to the Anglo-Saxon dogma of "private

enterprise" and corporations. The indigenous communities in Mexico, like those throughout the Americas, should have suffered dispossession through the imposition of privatization of their lands and of their lives, from the Mexico of Porfirio Díaz to the neoliberal wave hundred hundred years later. This millenary tradition, demonized *associalist*, does not count as *conservative*.

"*We will be here, defending the freedom of America*," reads a promotional phrase for the event. Which freedom? The freedom of the elites, supported by a part of the down thanks to political combos that include a bit of religion and "traditional values", such as family, machismo and hatred of others too much down. It is the same struggle for freedom of nineteenth-century slaveholders who they repeated that they expanded slavery to "*fight for civilization*" and "*civilization.*" *freedom.*" One of the presentations (entitled "*How to save freedom*" *religious?*") It's a classic on the right. Assume that *freedom* It is exercised when you put your sacred religion in a government and It fights the evil of secularism. Not without irony, secularism, secularism States were invented to protect religious freedoms, including the right to have no religion.

The American Conservative Union (ACU) and the CPAC were born and took control of the Republican Party from the 60s and 70s, as a reaction to the defeats before the Civil Rights Movement of Martin Luther King and others. This movement of "The Empire Strikes Back" is also a reaction, not only to the wave of defeats in Latin America but, above all, to the awareness that *this order is unsustainable* and sooner or later we will have a generation that will endanger the privileges of those above.

Yes We could stop in 1922 and ask ourselves, "*Is fascism the future?*" We wouldn't know what to answer. In 1940 we would have answered *yes* and *no* five years later.

One Once fascism succeeds in extending its power as far as it desires They will leave a trail of destruction and death. Then they will escape like rats, once more, back to anonymity and self-victimization.

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
