Fighting erupted between Afghanistan's Shia clerics over disrespect

April 13, 2015



A discussion over Shia Huthis in Yemen and their Imam Zainulabideen which also has followers in Afghanistan caused verbal conflict among members of the council of Shia Ulemas (clerics) of Afghanistan which ended up on physical fighting. Supporters of Ayatullah Mohsini, the head of the council, severely beat a member of the council.

Hussaini Mazari, a member of the council has written on his facebook page that Ayatullah Mohsini and Sayed Rahmatullah Murtaza had verbal conflict over Zainulabideen, the 3rd Imam of Shias and grandson of Hussain Ibn Ali ibn Abi Talib, on which both sides traded harsh words on Saturday.

He says that Ayatullah Mohsini put down the personality of Zainulabideen, also followed by Shia Huthis in Yemen, which was minded by Murtaza and they started to exchange harsh words.

He writes that after the verbal conflict Ayatullah Mohsini called his family members and ordered them to go and bring Sayed Rahmatullah Murtaza to him.

Sayed Rahmatullah Murtaza says around 25 gunmen including Hafiz, Ayatullah Mohsini's son and Jawad, his grandson arrived at his house and severely beaten him.

Murtaza further says that gunmen even entered to his room and shot fires threatening to kill him.

He says the marks of fires are visible in his room.

Sayed Rahmatullah Murtaza is a member of the council of Shia Muslims and Hezb-i-Wahdat Afghanistan who was an influential commander of Mujahideen during the Jihad era.
