## BREAKING: Eastern Ghouta's Jihadists are Ready to Cooperate

Militants from radical groups Faylaq al-Rahman have cut their ties with the <u>Tahrir al-Sham</u> terrorist organization with the aim to leave Eastern Ghouta. It is also reported about several clashes between militants of the two groups. The decision to split was taken after a number of demonstrations in the town of <u>Kafr Batna</u>.
