Gaza rockets retaliate against Israel

11/21/2012



Several rockets fired from the Gaza Strip have hit Israel's Sha'ar HaNegev regional council in the south, with no immediate reports of casualties.

Four explosions were heard in Israel's Eshkol regional council on Wednesday.

Meanwhile, the Izzeddin Qassam Brigades, the military wing of Hamas, said it has fired three Grad rockets at Migdal. The Qassam Brigades also said it has fired 10 Grad rockets at Israel's Hatzor airbase.

The Qassam Brigades added that they have fired more than 1,400 rockets and missiles into Israel over the past few days.

Several explosions were heard at Sderot and Eshkol.

Israel's Iron Dome missile shield has reportedly intercepted only 400 of over 1,400 projectiles fired from Gaza at Israel over the past days.

Several Palestinian rockets hit the Israeli cities of Be'er Sheva, Ashkelon and Shapir. Gazan missiles also targeted the city of Gan Yavne in central Israel.

Several buildings in Be'er Tuvia and Timorim, located near the city of Sderot, were hit by the Palestinian retaliatory rockets.

On Tuesday, an Israeli soldier and a civilian were killed in retaliatory rocket fire from Gaza by the Palestinian resistance fighters targeting the Eshkol region in southern Israel. Reports say at least 15 Israeli troopers were also injured.

The incident brought to five the number of people killed in the Palestinian response to the nonstop Israeli attacks on the Gaza Strip. Some 45 Israelis, including 20 troopers, have been injured in the retaliatory attacks.

Also on Tuesday, at least four people were wounded when a Palestinian missile hit a building in the Israeli city of Rishon LeZion, south of Tel Aviv. Another Israeli was also injured in the settlement of Gush Etzion, when al-Quds (Jerusalem) was targeted by the Palestinian retaliatory fire.
