Explosion in Ghazni leaves at least 18 civilians dead

October 27, 2013

At least 18 people including women and children have been killed following a deadly roadside bomb explosion in eastern Ghazni province of Afghanistan.

According to reports, the incident took place late Sunday in Andar district after a civilian vehicle struck with a roadside bomb.

Eyewitnesses in the area are saying that majority of the victims are women and children, and the incident took place while they were on their way towards a wedding ceremony.

Deputy provincial governor, Ahmad Ali Ahmadi said 14 women, 2 men and 2 children were killed in the blast and 5 others were injured.

Asadullah Insafi, deputy provincial security chief also confirmed the death toll and said the health condition of 2 women who were injured in the blast are critical.

No group including the Taliban militants has so far claimed responsibility behind the incident.
