Colonel Desmond Travers, member of the famous Goldstone commission »:We visited the same places. The film confirms our findings many months later. It is important that people should be allowed to see the film and make up their own mind on what happened during those three weeks, when the Israeli forces attacked. In fact, the 500 pages Goldstone report, describes facts in a technical and judicial language which might put some people off from reading it. By watching the film, I was made to remember that the situation in Gaza has worsen still since those images were filmed, a year and a half ago« .

The documentary shows the investigation of a human rights delegation after the criminal attack by Israel on Gaza in 2008. The war crimes committed include: systematic bombing of civilian houses, execution of civilians inclusive elderly, women and children, systematic destruction of agricultural land and olive plantations, killings of animals (livestock, cattle, etc.), destruction of factories and mosques, use of prohibited weapons (phosphor, shrapnel), bombing of UN school and warehouses.

Since then, Israel continues to starve Gaza killing mainly civilians .
