Afghan VP, minister escape attack

The rocket hit an area near the police center in the Chaki Wardak district of Wardak province in central Afghanistan, injuring two policemen, a Press TV correspondent reported on Wednesday.

The incident occurred when the two top Afghan officials were inaugurating the police center. They escaped the attack unscathed.

Although Taliban have not officially claimed responsibility for the attack, Afghan sources are blaming the militant group for the assault.

Security situation in the conflict-riddled Asian country continues to deteriorate with foreign and Afghan forces falling prey to Taliban attacks on a nearly daily basis.

The recent attack seems to be part of an assassination campaign that Taliban have begun across Afghanistan as the militants launched a similar attack in the northeastern Kapisa province on Wednesday, killing eight people and wounding four others.

Taliban militants and supporters of former al-Qaeda leader Osama bin Laden have vowed to intensify their assaults in retaliation for the alleged killing of bin Laden in early May.

Thousands of Afghans have so far been killed during ground and aerial operations by foreign troops.

NATO has admitted that the power of militants in Afghanistan is on the rise despite the presence of about 150,000 US-led forces in the country.
