Foreign forces behind insecurity: Iran

“Iran and Pakistan are trying to take positive steps to resolve security problems, fight organized crime and drug trafficking and [deal with] regional challenges,” he said in a meeting with Pakistan's President Asif Ali Zardari.

The Iranian minister, who arrived in Islamabad on an official two-day visit on Wednesday, expressed hope that the two countries would cooperate more cultural, scientific, economic and security issues, IRNA reported.

Pakistan's president, for his part, thanked Iran for sending aid to flood victims in Pakistan and underlined the need for bolstering bilateral relation and praised the cooperation of the Iranian and Pakistani interior ministries on fighting insurgents along common border.

Iran has so far sent 40 tons of aid including food, medicines and clothing for flood-stricken people in south Pakistan.

The meeting was attended by Pakistani Interior Minister Rehman Malik and Iran's Ambassador to Islamabad Mashaallah Shakeri.
